The Pavilion & courts are situated in Morton Park, at the corner of Central & Blackburn roads, near the War Memorial and adjacent to the Blackburn Library. Our Melways Reference is 48 A10.

The Blackburn Tennis Club was established early in 1922 and has always provided both social and competition tennis to the local community. Prior to the first World War (1913 to 1918) there was a strong Club using the two good asphalt courts previously situated just east of the Morton Park Hall (now replaced by the Blackburn Library). During the war this Club became practically defunct, and following the war, the two courts were being used by only a few former Club members on a social basis. At the end of 1921, a number of local residents, mainly members of the Church of England Tennis Club in Queen Street, Blackburn, became interested in the courts at Morton Park, and approached the Nunawading Council about taking over the courts to form a new Tennis Club – permission was given by the Council and a special meeting was organized on the 15th of February 1922 in the Morton Park Hall, which resulted in the new Blackburn Tennis Club being formed.

Since the 15th of February 1922, the Blackburn Tennis Club has actively continued and progressed under the guidance of devoted and energetic volunteers, and now with seven porous courts (all of which are lit to competition standard) and a modern, well equipped Pavilion, ranks as one of the strongest Clubs in the Eastern suburbs. The Club caters for over 300 members of all ages and standards who enjoy their tennis in many ways including:

Senior Regional Competition - (Saturday Afternoons)

The Club enters teams in the Eastern Region Tennis Association - usually in the Open Doubles Sets Category. The Club also enters teams in the Bayside Regional Tennis Association Singles/Doubles Competition during the summer season.

Junior Regional Competition - (Sat. & Sun. Mornings)

The junior program is an important part of the Club and we enter junior teams in both the Saturday & Sunday morning Eastern Region Tennis Junior Competitions. Our junior team numbers are above average and this allows us to cater for a wide range of standards.

Ladies Mid-Week Tennis

Our Club enters teams in the MEMRLTA mid-week ladies competition catering for all standards. Again this competition is conducted on a summer & winter season basis with matches being played on Tuesdays. Additionally our ladies enjoy social tennis on Monday, Wednesday & Friday mornings with all standards participating. We also have an "In-House" Thursday Morning Ladies Competition.

Night Tennis

The Club enters teams in the Blackburn & District Night Tennis Association and has teams competing four nights a week. Monday nights is for ladies teams only and "Open" teams are entered on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday nights. The Club usually has ~18 night teams competing each season and the income generated from the night tennis has enabled the Club to continue to improve & maintain the facilities for all members and visitors. Players enjoy the social atmosphere of the Night Competition and also choose their own teams. The night competition caters for all standards from beginner adult to advanced levels. Other Social Tennis

A small group of players continue to play social tennis on Sunday afternoons from approximately 2.00p.m. onwards. All senior members are welcome to come down and join in!!! On Thursday afternoons from approx. 2.00p.m. some of our older male members play social tennis and look forward to welcoming some new fellows to their ranks.
